

GOT TALENT - 2IN EDV CHALLENGE

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1st Clause - Context

1. The **Got Talent – 2IN edv Challenge** is a competition promoted by *ADRITEM – Associação de Desenvolvimento Regional Integrado das Terras de Santa Maria*, under the Got Talent Project, financed by the *Estrutura de Missão Portugal Inovação Social* - through the funding line *Programa de Parcerias para o Impacto* and *PO ISE* with the operation number 03-4639-FSE-000767.
2. It is intended for teams with ideas/ projects that seek to solve/ minimize serious and neglected social and/ or environmental problems, with a local and regional scope, through innovative solutions.
3. It aims to promote the entrepreneurial spirit and endorse a culture of social innovation among "young talents", promoting the expansion of knowledge and involvement on current societal issues. Furthermore, it intends to encourage creativity and proactivity and to facilitate the development of soft skills, as well as fostering the spirit of initiative and teamwork.

2nd Clause - Eligibility and Applications

1. **Participants:** are eligible to apply young people, over the age of 18, attending polytechnic, university or post-university education and any qualified adult population (level 5 or superior), employed or unemployed, organized in teams of 2 (two) to 4 (four) elements.

2. **Application:** to apply, each team must fill out an online application form, available on the Got Talent website (www.gottalent.pt). After submission, an email will be sent to the team confirming the application.
3. **Deadline:** the application form must be submitted by 23:59 on February 27th, 2022 (Sunday).
4. **Exclusions:** any direct family member of the *ADRITEM* Team or of the Jury is automatically excluded from participation.

3rd Clause - Selection

1. Only 20 (twenty) teams will be selected to participate in the Got Talent - 2 IN edv Challenge [consisting of at least 2 (two) people up to a maximum of 4 (four)].
2. Teams will be selected based on the **following 5 (five) evaluation criteria** (each weighting 20% for the final score):
 - Candidates' motivation for participating.
 - Relevance of the social and/or environmental issue/ problem selected, and severity of its consequences.
 - How innovative and impactful the solution is.
 - Experience, knowledge, and skill of each of the team members.
 - Potential for replicability and/ or scalability of the idea/ project.
3. Applications will be evaluated by a jury and the candidates will be informed of the results through the email address provided as the team's preferred contact in the application form.

4. Registration will only be considered valid by *ADRITEM* if the confirmation email sent after the submission of the application form is responded, ensuring that the team members are committed to participating in all stages of the competition.

4th Clause - Program

1. The Got Talent - 2 IN edv Challenge is organized in 4 (four) sequential stages:

- Stage 1 - Selection of the 20 best ideas/ projects submitted

- Stage 2 - Pre-Acceleration Bootcamp

A 5-day training program that aims to explore and apply, as a team, various entrepreneurial methodologies, as well as to foment the acquisition of skills considered essential to lead and create in a collaborative context.

At the end of this stage, 5 (five) ideas/ projects will be selected to proceed to the next stage.

- Stage 3 - Acceleration Program

Acceleration and development of the best 5 (five) ideas/ projects resultant from Stage 1.

An intensive mentoring program for the development of the projects' business model, totalling 12 (twelve) hours of mentorship per team.

- Stage 4 - Shark Tank

The ultimate evaluation, through the pitching of the projects to potential investors.

2. The schedule for the Got Talent – 2IN edv Challenge is as follows:

3. The timing and scheduling of all activities will be disclosed to the selected teams in the results' announcement email, between **April 4th to 11th, 2022**.
4. The specific location of the activities will also be made known in said email.
5. Depending on the origin of the participants/ teams, some activities may occur online.
6. To be considered for the final Shark Tank, the teams must attend all the foreseen and aforementioned stages of the Got Talent - 2IN edv Challenge.

5th Clause - Accountability

During the Got Talent - 2IN edv Challenge, each participant/ team commits to:

- Provide any and all information about the project as requested, given its relevance to the participation;
- Respect and comply with assiduity and punctuality, according to the pre-established schedule;
- Authorize the communication and dissemination of public information about the project on the *ADRITEM*/ Got Talent social media platforms;
- Acknowledge and accept that, in case of non-compliance with any of the above obligations, *ADRITEM* may - if such non-compliance damages the effectiveness and/ or quality of the competition - decide to suspend or exclude said participant/ team.

6th Clause - Confidentiality

1. All data collected shall be kept in strict confidentiality and not used for any purpose other than those within the scope of this competition.

2. The processing of personal data is carried out in strict compliance with the legislation on the protection of personal data, in accordance with the provisions of the *Regulamento Geral sobre a Proteção de Dados* (RGPD) and/ or any legislation amending it.

7th Clause - Intellectual Property

1. The participant accepts that all ideas/ projects developed during this competition, as well as the collaborations between the participants/ teams, are intellectual property (IP) of the participant and his/ her team (the Author).
2. Participants will not use any original idea to generate revenue without the Author's permission.
3. Participants shall not disclose any information about an original idea without the Author's permission.
4. IP and the work developed before, during and after the competition belongs to the participant and his/her team.
5. ADRITEM may disclose the results published and/or submitted during the competition.
6. The ideas/ projects submitted to this competition ought to be able for execution in the *Entre Douro e Vouga/ Terras de Santa Maria* region and, upon submission, the teams automatically authorize the implementation of their idea/ project in this territory by others, if they do not intend to do so or do not do so within 1 (one) year (starting April 4th, 2022).

8th Clause - Final Considerations

1. The resolution of supervening issues not provided for in this document is of the sole and sovereign responsibility of *ADRITEM*.
2. By submitting the application form, applicants declare that they have read and agreed to the Terms and Conditions described in the present document and recognize *ADRITEM*'s right to resolve or change the terms of the Got Talent - 2 IN edv Challenge when and if necessary.
3. The deadlines and dates contained in this document may be amended if *ADRITEM* decides to, given they will be made public in due time.
4. The submission of the application does not coerce *ADRITEM* to its selection.
5. The submitted data is the responsibility of the candidates.

7. The application for the Got Talent - 2 IN edv Challenge implies the full knowledge and unreserved acceptance of the Terms and Conditions provided for in the present document.
