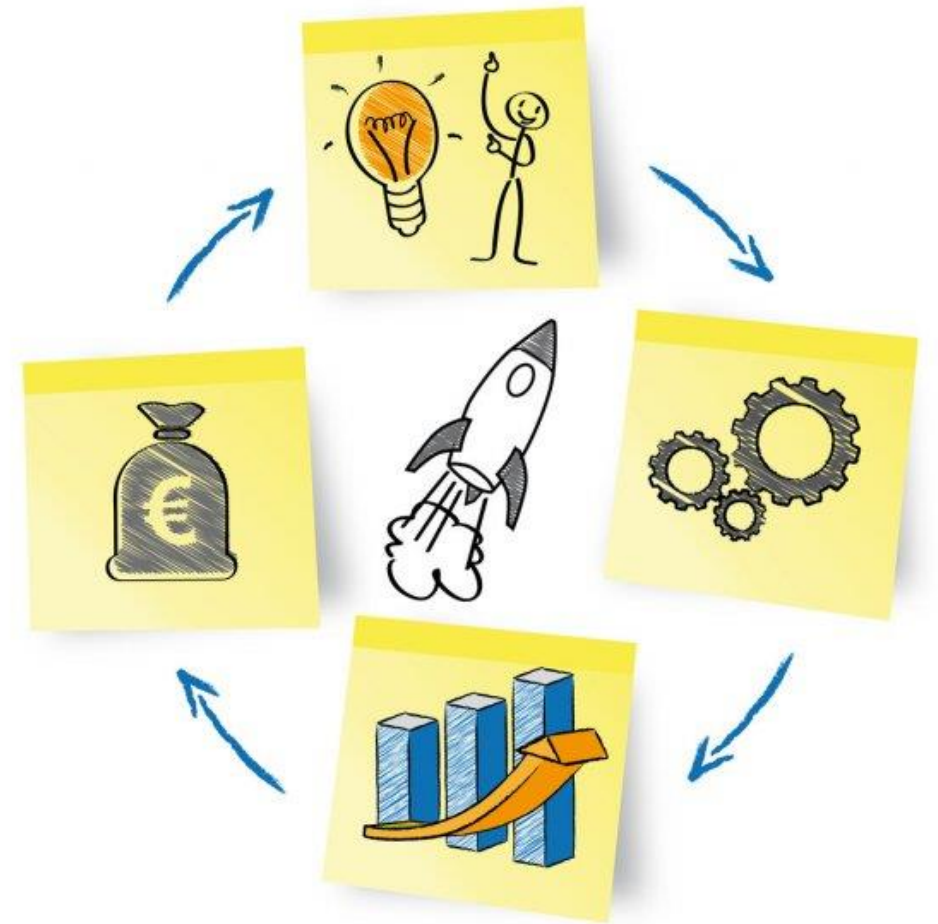
Mission

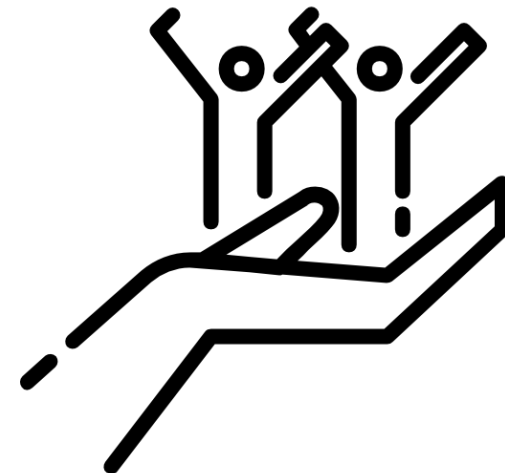
Creation/dynamization of Local/ National/ International Aid Networks

BENEFICIARIES - CATEGORY ENTREPRENEURSHIP / START YOUR OWN BUSINESS

- The individual competitor must be 18 or over, reside in Portugal and have Refugee Status*
- Competing collectives and teams must include people of 18-years-old or over, residing in Portugal, with at least one having Refugee Status*

→ Individual, Collective or Team up to 4 elements!

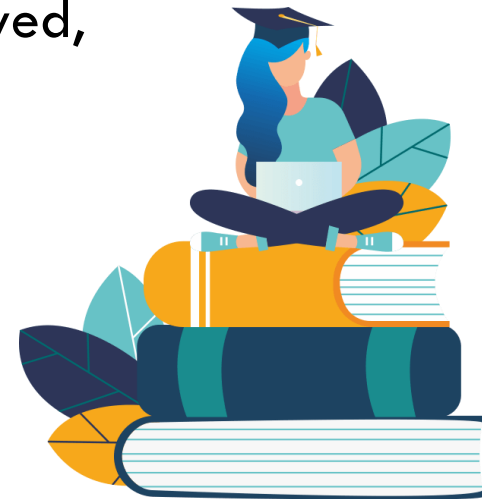
*(especially, but not exclusively, of Ukrainian nationality)



BENEFICIARIES - CATEGORY SOCIAL INNOVATION

- To apply individually, applicants must be aged 18 or over and must reside in Portugal. They can be of any nationality and be students, employed or unemployed.
- To be able to apply, teams must include people aged 18 or over, residing in Portugal, of any nationality (e.g. students, employed, unemployed, organizations, municipalities, ...).

→ Individual, Collective or Team up to 4 elements!

- **Shark Tank** – opportunity to pitch the project to a panel of potential investors

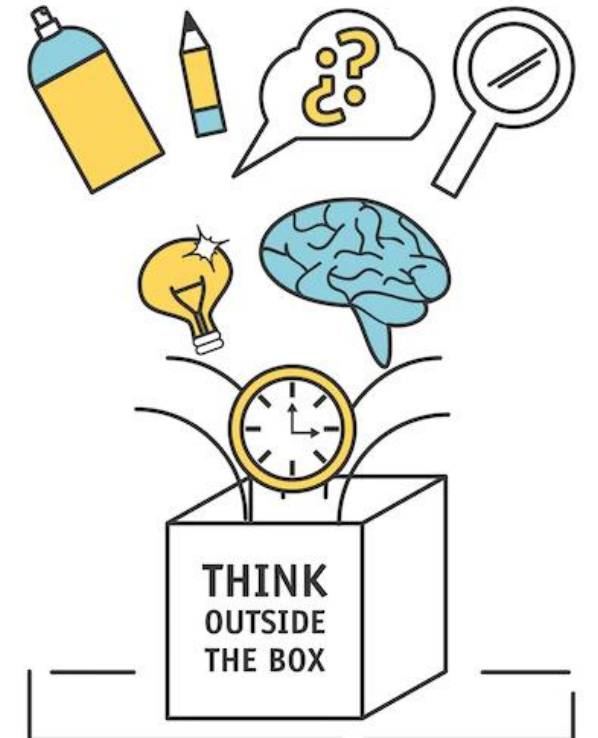

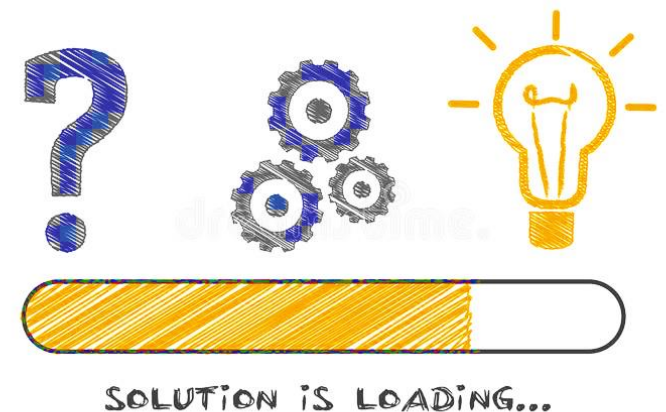
To apply, you must fill in the application form, available at the Got Talent website (www.gottalent.pt).
